
FIRST CALL FOR STUDENT INTERNATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM

The application shall include the approved ORW title as per NAHEP-CAAST thematic area/ Animal Food Safety in the disciplines mentioned in approved DPR (Veterinary Public Health, Food Hygiene and Public Health, Animal Nutrition, Livestock Products Technology, Veterinary Microbiology, Animal Biotechnology, Veterinary Medicine, Veterinary Pathology, Veterinary Parasitology and Veterinary Physiology).

PROPOSED GUIDELINES FOR SELECTION OF STUDENTS FOR INTERNATIONAL TRAINING UNDER ICAR-NAHEP-CAAST

NAHEP provides scope for international exposure to post-graduate students (Masters and Ph.D.) under CAAST through student training programs with reputed international universities. P.G./Ph.D. students here refer to only those who are associated with CAAST related research work.

The students for overseas training/internship would be identified based on the overall score obtained by the candidates evaluated as per the scorecard developed specifically for this purpose based on the parameters given below:

1. (i) Academic performance (50%)
(ii) Evaluation of cognition levels of learning in subject matter/specialization (20%),
(iii) Character, conduct, personality and team spirit (20%),
(iv) Personal interview (10%).
2. Overall, 33.33 per cent of the slots may be reserved for girl students. In case, the girls' enrollment is overriding boys, due representation may be provided.
3. The student identified should possess minimum attendance prescribed by the university in all the subjects.
4. Eligible Criteria
 - a) Candidates should possess a CGPA of 7.5 and above and should not have any repeat courses as on the date of cognitive evaluation (examination).
 - b) For SC/ST categories CGPA of 7.0 & above.
5. The profile of the candidates identified for international exposure should be socially inclusive in consonance with the Equity Action Plan committed to the World Bank.
6. The final evaluation and scoring for deciding the eligibility should be within the categories identified as per EAP.
7. It is mandatory for all the eligible candidates to appear in the cognitive evaluation and personal interview.
8. The date for evaluation of cognition levels of learning in chosen/ identified field of training should be widely publicized and separately notified.
A similar examination in CAAST relevant course and research work for P.G./Ph.D. students may be conducted to assess their eligibility.
9. The candidates should submit documentary proofs to claim scores under the parameters (1), (3) and (4)
10. On selection the candidate will be eligible for to and fro air travel, living allowance, stay allowance and scholarship as per the NAHEP-CAAST student international internship and Annexure-1 guidelines.
11. A committee constituted at university level as per Revised Guidelines after 2nd NSC Meeting 2019, would carry out the personal interview of the eligible candidates.
12. The identification of the candidates as per these broad guidelines supplemented by university specific metrics in development of score card is the responsibility of the university.
