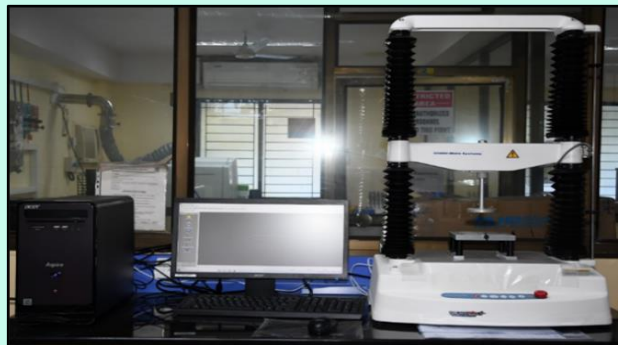
To access the exit and entry of personnel in the lab, biometric machine was installed and to ensure the security CCTV cameras were also installed.
